Latest company innovations

The company can report that considerable inroads have been made with its printing technology since its commercial launch in 2011, with four references to date. The company has also developed a new in-line slitting winder, Nexus. Nexus represents the top of the range in-line slitting to produce high quality slit reels. It features an innovative cross cutting system to minimize scrap during doffing. A.Celli Nonwovens has recently applied its expertise of winding and slitting nonwovens to develop innovative spooling technology. Its spooling machinery is currently capable of production speeds of up to 600 m/min guaranteeing maximum flexibility and higher throughput thanks to its non-stop doffing capability. One industrial line has been sold to date.
